Monika has been listed among Variety's 10 Cinematographers to Watch 2016.

Her work has been selected in numerous film festivals including Sundance (nominantion for best cinematography in 2014 for DIFRET – EP Angelina Jolie), Cannes, Tribeca, Rotterdam and Camerimage (Cinematographers' Debuts Competition). Monika is a cinematographer of over thirty award-winning short and feature-length films including Chiki Anadu's B FOR BOY, Malik Vitthal's IMPERIAL DREAMS and Sofia Exarchou's PARK. Monika participated in the Sundance Directors Lab 2014. In 2015, Monika also served as DOP in her first full-length Polish film STRANGE HEAVEN directed by Dariusz Gajewski. Monika is the cinematographer in MESSAGE FROM THE KING directed by Fabrice Du Welz, starring Alfred Molina, produced by David Lancaster (DRIVE, WHIPLASH and NIGHTCRAWLER). The film is currently in post-production.

Monika's experience includes feature films, shorts and commercials.

Monika is a member of the International Cinematographers Guild (ICG) and Polish Society of Cinematographers (PSC).

Monika graduated with a Masters Degree from the Department of Film and Television from the University of Silesia in Poland and completed an MFA in Cinematography at the American Film Institute.
